This intensive, five-day summer workshop is designed for Buffalo-area high school students heading into their sophomore, junior or senior year who have a serious interest in journalism. The workshop will introduce students to basic skills in news reporting, writing, editing, interviewing and the use of video. Students will get hands-on experience using Buffalo State's state-of-the-art equipment and facilities. Buffalo State faculty and professional journalists from the area will teach the sessions. Guest speakers and special guests have been invited. Students will produce original work across several multi-media platforms that will be posted online at the end of the week.
