Post-Production Diversity Initiative - COM's new Post-Production Diversity Initiative



(PPDI) held its orientation Nov. 1! Participants got to connect with one another, pairing up to answer questions about what inspired them to pursue working in post-production. They also reviewed the schedule for the sessions that PPDI will be hosting during the year-long program from November 2024 to August 2025. PPDI is a collaboration between Buffalo State University, the Motion Picture Editors Guild – New York, the media company Avid, and Buffalo FilmWorks. Funded by a New York State Entertainment Workforce Diversity Grant, PPDI is a one-year program that prepares

participants from diverse backgrounds, including Buffalo State students and community members, for entry-level careers in video editing and audio mixing in the highly competitive music, video, and media industries. The grant proposal was written by COM Professor **Dorothea Braemer**, with **Robin Lazzara** as the project manager.

Alumni Receive Broadcasting Awards – Congratulations to three COM alumni for their achievements in broadcasting! The Buffalo Broadcasters Association inducted retired broadcasters Jim DiMino '75 and Howard Simon '84 into its Hall of Fame, and Joe Cali '24, who is employed by WGR Sports Radio and News Radio 930 WBEN, received the Rising Star Award at BBA's annual Hall of Fame awards dinner on Sept. 19.
